





Lurie Children's Summer Internship Program

The Division of Orthopaedic Surgery and Sports Medicine supports undergraduate and graduate students who are interested in an educational experience designed for the intern to learn more about clinical research in orthopaedics and sports medicine. Coordinated by the research staff, and under the supervision of the physician scientists, the Summer Research Intern Program is designed to provide students with an educational experience that will allow them to gain practical experience through exposure to research project(s) within the division, attendance at weekly research meetings, and participation in research seminars and trainings. Being an intern at Lurie Children's offers vast exposure to clinical research and the world of medicine. Interns were exposed to real life situations in the clinical research area, including being able to shadow various clinicians in clinic and likely in surgery. This educational experience ran from June – August and we are excited to share the work from this summer's interns.



SUMMER INTERNS

Jonathan Hau — Low Neighborhood Opportunity as a Risk Factor for Late Diagnosis of Developmental Dysplasia of the Hip

The purpose of this retrospective chart review is to examine whether low neighborhood opportunity score is associated with late presentation of DDH.

Betsy Merritt — Comparison Of Early Complications Following Combined ACL and ALL Reconstruction vs. Isolated ACL Reconstruction in Children and Adolescents

The objective is to identify differences in early complication rates following isolated ACLR vs. combined ACLR + ALL reconstruction in pediatric patients.

Iggy Nah — Substratification of the Post-Concussion Symptom Scale (PCSS) as a Return-To-Play (RTP) Predictive Measure

The purpose is to investigate whether or not specific symptom subcategories can prove to be better predictors of return-to-play, which can lead to a shorter duration of medical clearance, focused therapies, and greater access to health information for patients.

Alex Slomba — Discoid Medial and Lateral Menisci of the Knee: Characteristics and Treatment Outcomes

This study aims to review demographics, procedures, and outcomes of patients treated with discoid medial and/or lateral menisci, an understudied anomaly that is associated with a higher incidence of meniscal tearing and instability.
